OBSERVED VIOLATIONS:

15A North Carolina Administrative Code 13B .1404 (a) A site shall meet the following requirements at the time of initial permitting and shall continue to meet these requirements throughout the life of the permit only on the property owned or controlled by the applicant or by the landowner(s) at the time of permitting: (2) A 100-foot minimum buffer is required between all property lines and compost areas for Type 3 and 4 facilities, 50-foot for Type 1 or 2 facilities.

Cantrell Construction and Holding Company is in violation of 15A North Carolina Administrative Code 13B .1404 (a) (2) in that on February 5, 2016 waste was observed within 50 feet of the northern property line.

In order to achieve compliance, within 30 days of receipt of this inspection report, Cantrell Construction and Holding Company must remove all waste and finished material within the 50-foot buffer required between all property lines.

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The item(s) listed above were observed by Section staff and require action on behalf of the facility in order to come into or maintain compliance with the Statutes, Rules, and/or other regulatory requirements applicable to this facility. Be advised that pursuant to N.C.G.S. 130A-22, an administrative penalty of up to \$15,000 per day may be assessed for each violation of the Solid Waste Laws, Regulations, Conditions of a Permit, or Order under Article 9 of Chapter 130A of the N.C. General Statutes. Further, the facility and/or all responsible parties may also be subject to enforcement actions including penalties, injunction from operation of a solid waste management facility or a solid waste collection service and any such further relief as may be necessary to achieve compliance with the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Act and Rules.

**ADDITIONAL COMMENTS**

1. All photos were taken by Lee Hill on February 5, 2016.
2. The notification is active until May 31, 2016
3. A gate was located at the entrance to the facility. The gate was open upon arrival to the site.
4. Signs were located at the entrance of the site stating "Dumping By Permission Only!" and "Absolutely no painted or treated wood accepted. No cross ties!!"
5. Land clearing debris was dumped in the entrance to the facility.
6. Material was stockpiled on the north side of the facility within the 50-foot property line buffer. **Waste and finished material must be kept a minimum of 50 feet away from all property lines.** Please see observed violations section of report.

7. No unacceptable material was observed on site at the time of inspection. Please continue to remove any unacceptable material and dispose of it properly.
8. A large stockpile of un-ground land clearing material was observed on site. Some areas of the waste stockpile were in excess of 12 feet tall. **Please note that a Yard Waste Notification site cannot process or store more than 6000 cubic yards of waste and finished material per three month period.**
