The Groundwater Section of the Winston-Salem Regional Office is now reviewing the UST closure assessment for the subject location. In order to determine whether or not the closure was performed in accordance with State and Federal regulations, the Groundwater Section must be provided with the following information by February 5, 1992:

Confirmation that all contaminated soils excavated from the site have been remediated to <10 ppm TPH.

The Groundwater Section of this office regrets the delay in contacting you on this matter, which was caused by the vast number of UST closures in the Winston-Salem Regional Office area. Your co-operation is appreciated. Please refer to the file name, Interstate Trucking, Former, Patterson Avenue, Winston-Salem, Forsyth County, on the cover letter of your reply.
