In response to the above referenced letter analytical results from soil samples collected from the stockpiles of contaminated soil at this facility have been included in the reimbursement package in the Lab Analysis section of the package. During tank removal, only samples for clean closure were collected for laboratory analysis. Samples of contaminated soil were not collected for analysis during tank removal. We are of the opinion that analytical results for the stockpile samples confirm that a release had occurred in the tank farm.
