Dear Mr. Burton:

Based on the current groundwater quality data and the future development plans for the site, future active remediation of the soil and groundwater using stationary equipment does not appear to be warranted at this time. This assumes that all the permanent equipment installed will be decommissioned and removed. At this time ExxonMobil wishes to pursue a No Further Action (NFA) by either enlarging MW-2 and pumping for extended periods of time, or by reconfiguring or replumbing the well so as to sample MW-2 outside of the building.
