Dear Mr. Coble:

On behalf of Exxon Company, U.S.A., ERM-Southeast, Inc. is providing you with a progress report for environmental assessment and remediation activities that are being conducted at the above referenced site. Mr. Michael Zappia of the Guilford County Department of Public Health reviewed the Comprehensive Site Assessment (CSA) report for the site that was submitted in October 1993 and found that additional assessment activities would be required for the CSA to be considered complete. The deadline for submittal of the revised CSA is December 29, 1995.

Additional soil and ground water data for the site were specified by Mr. Zappia. ERM-Southeast collected additional soil quality data on August 30, 1995. Off-site access for the installation of a monitor well was obtained in November 1995. The monitor well was installed and ground water quality data was collected in December 1995.

Exxon has also completed the installation of the soil vapor extraction and air sparging remediation system that was proposed in the site Corrective Action Plan that was submitted to DEM in July 1994. The system is expected to be operational in January 1996.

In view of the ongoing assessment and remediation activities that are being conducted at the site, ERM-Southeast requests that the deadline for submittal of the site CSA report be extended until February 29, 1996.
