On behalf of Exxon Company, U.S.A., Nightingale Geologic Consultants, P.C. and Griffith Enterprises, Inc. are requesting an extension for submittal of a UST Closure Report for one 1,000 gallon used oil UST that was closed by removal on February 9, 1998. An extension is being requested so that soil and residual fluid manifests, which are not yet available, can be included with the report. These documents should be available within 45 days. As such, the proposed extended submittal date for the report is May 5, 1998.

Laboratory analysis of two confirmation soil samples collected at the time of the UST closure did not indicate the presence of detectable concentrations of TPH, volatile organic compounds, or semi-volatile organic compounds in soil beneath the UST. The following metals were detected:

- ♦ Sample 1: 9.74 mg/kg chromium, 3.38 mg/kg lead.
- ♦ Sample 2: 8.82 mg/kg chromium, 2.50 mg/kg lead.
- ♦ Stockpile: 23.90 mg/kg chromium, 2.88 mg/kg lead.
