On or around November, 1994, Legacy Environmental Services, Inc. was informed of a notice of violation of N.C.A.C. Title 15A Subchapter 2L received by Melvin Yarboro. On behalf of our client, contained herein is our formal response for this matter in accordance with the requirements of your submittal dated September 2, 1994.

It is our intent to achieve complete compliance with the requirements of the rules and regulations. Legacy plans to enter into a co-payment agreement with Mr. Yarboro in order to complete CSA and CAP activities.

Since this project will be conducted on a copayment basis, a 90 day extension is requested at this time. This request is made in order to facilitate scheduling of copayment jobs with internal budget restrictions. Our observed payment process period for recent trust fund submittals has averaged 6 months and we currently have 3 large copayment packages awaiting processing.

Mr. Coble, thank you for consideration of this request. Legacy will complete a Comprehensive Site Assessment Report and forward it to the your office as soon as possible.
