NOTICE OF VIOLATION OF SUBCHAPTER 2N
CRITERIA AND STANDARDS APPLICABLE TO
UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS

Dear Sirs:

On November 13, 1989, this office was informed (or determined) that an underground storage tank system (UST) at the subject location is not in compliance with North Carolina Administrative Code (NCAC Title 15A Subchapter 2N "Criteria and Standards Applicable to Underground Storage Tanks"). It is our understanding that you and/or your firm are the owner/operator of the UST System. If you feel that you are not responsible for the following violations, please notify this office within seven (7) working days.

The violation(s) is(are) as follows:

Failure to give proper initial response to a confirmed release from the UST System as outlined in 15A NCAC 2N .0702. Within 24 hours of receipt of this notice you must do the following: a) report your actions to this office, b) take immediate action to prevent any further release of the regulated substance into the environment and,

c) identify and mitigate fire, explosion, and vapor hazards.

Failure to conduct and/or report initial abatement measures and site check (aka 20-day report) as outlined in 15A NCAC 2N .0703 within the time frame stated in the "Notification of Federal Release Response Requirements" (NOFRR) of November 21, 1989. Upon receipt of this notice you must file a report addressing all the requirements of section 15A NCAC 2N .0703 by April 15, 1993.

Failure to perform and/or report the initial site characterization (aka 45-day report) as outlined in 15A NCAC 2N .0704 within the time frame stated in the NOFRR of November 21, 1989. Upon receipt of this notice you must file a report with this office addressing all the requirements of section 15A NCAC 2N .0704 by April 15, 1993.

Failure to conduct and/or report free product removal as outlined in 15A NCAC 2N .0705. You must begin removing the free product within 72 hours of receipt of this notice and file the required report within 45 days. Also, contact this office within 24 hours of receipt of this notice.

Failure to conduct and/or report the investigation for soil and ground-water clean-up (aka Comprehensive Site Assessment) as outlined in 15A NCAC 2N .0706 within the time frame stated in the NOFRR of November 21, 1989. Upon receipt of this notice you must file a report addressing all the requirements of section 15A NCAC 2N .0706 by April 15, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the aforementioned criteria and standards may result in enforcement action against you which may include: (1) a civil penalty assessment of up to \$10,000 for each day of continuing violation (G.S. 143-215.6), (2) criminal penalty proceedings under circumstance as outlined under G.S. 143-215.6B, (3) referral of your site to the Federal Trust Fund which must seek cost recovery from responsible parties for any and all expenses incurred, (4) a request to the Attorney General to institute an action for injunctive relief and, (5) the issuance of a special order.
