

Dear Mr. Zappia:

We have received the DEHNR request for additional information concerning the Corrective Action plan (CAP) for the above referenced site (letter dated May 7, 1996), and we are in the process of complying with the request. A replacement for monitoring well MW-5 is being installed, and all wells will be resampled and resurveyed presently. Also the modeling will be redone using benzene as the modeled constituent. These and the other requested information will be forwarded to your office as a revised CAP as soon as the results are available.

In the mean-time, our client, Lindley Property Trust, has requested that we proceed with the proposed corrective action, i.e. - excavation and disposal of the contaminated soil on the site, as soon as possible. We have scheduled the excavation to begin next week, May 28-31. If you have any questions or comments, please call me. If we do not hear from you, we will proceed as scheduled.
