Dear Mr. Bryant:

On March 16, 2016, Liz Patterson and Drew Hammonds, representing the State of North Carolina, Division of Waste Management Solid Waste Section (Section), inspected the above referenced facility for compliance with North Carolina solid waste statutes and rules. The following violation(s) were noted:

- A. 15A NCAC 13B .0566(14), "Leachate shall be properly managed on site through the use of current best management practices."**

Leachate breakout has occurred on the southeastern slope of the landfill and appears to have flowed to the existing sediment trap which has overflowed into the vegetative buffer.

By May 9, 2016, corrective actions need to occur so as to stop the flow of leachate from the landfill.

The violation(s) listed above were observed by Section staff and require action on behalf of the facility in order to come into or maintain compliance with the Statutes, Rules, and/or other regulatory requirements applicable to this facility. Be advised that pursuant to N.C.G.S. 130A-22, an administrative penalty of up to \$15,000 per day may be assessed for each violation of the Solid Waste Laws, Regulations, Conditions of a Permit, or Order under Article 9 of Chapter 130A of the N.C. General Statutes. Further, the facility and/or all responsible parties may also be subject to enforcement actions including penalties, injunction from operation of a solid waste management facility or a solid waste collection service and any such further relief as may be necessary to achieve compliance with the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Act and Rules.

In addition to the violation noted above, please note that items #2, #7, #8, #10, #11, #12, #14, and #15 on the inspection report required additional action on behalf of the facility in the next 30 days to ensure compliance is maintained at this facility. Should these items not be addressed in that time frame, the facility will be subject to future enforcement action(s).

Please keep me informed of your progress in this matter. Solid Waste Section staff will conduct a follow-up inspection to verify that the facility has completed the requirements of this Notice of Violation.
