
I have considered the information submitted in support of your request for remission in accordance with G.S. 143-215.6A(f) and my delegation under G.S. 143-215.6A(h), and have decided to remit the civil penalty in this matter to the amount of \$0.00.

This remittance is contingent upon completion of permanent closure of the 550-gallon gasoline underground storage tank (UST) located at Springfield Baptist Church, 1322 Baker Road, High Point, Guilford County, North Carolina under the supervision of Guilford County and within 60-days of receipt of this notice. Permanent closure of this UST must be conducted in accordance with the provisions of North Carolina Administrative Code (NCAC) Title 15A, Subchapter 2N, Sections .0802 and .0803. For your convenience, a UST closure package is enclosed herein.

Please be advised that failure to complete the conditions stated herein constitutes a rejection of the penalty modification offered above, and the original penalty amount, along with additional penalties, may be assessed in this matter. Additionally, remittance of this civil penalty assessment in no way precludes the Division from taking enforcement actions against you should future violations occur.
