This correspondence pertains to our conversation on September 16, 1988 involving the subject property. As we discussed, the February 19, 1988 soil sample analysis is insufficient to adequately identify the possibility of contamination at the subject site. Therefore, it is requested that at least three (3) soil samples be collected from the underground storage tank (UST) excavation area and analyzed for total petroleum hydrocarbons utilizing an approved EPA test method. The sample results should be submitted to this office on or before December 26, 1988.
