good morning

I do not have a copy of a closure letter for #10076, Elm St Sunoco-REGUST. Nor does the incident file or database reflect closure of this incident.

Incident #14203 is recorded as Elm St Sunoco-NONREG. Priority E180. I do not have the time available presently to review this file or to write an advisory letter.

I can advise that the "180" score would prompt me to closely evaluate any available data to see if the site would be currently risk-ranked "Intermediate".

Because incident #14203 does not have an approved CSA on record, it would have to meet risk-based closure guidelines to qualify for a No Further Action Letter.

In general, older (non-CSA) sites transitioning to risk-based rules should follow the flowchart on page 16 of the guidelines starting with the LSA step.
