Dear Mr. Shine:

This letter is to acknowledge the receipt of Comprehensive Site Assessment dated August 9, 1993, and to remind you of your legal requirements in regard to State Regulations. Under current Regulations, as responsible party, you are required to continue to take the steps necessary to clean up the site and restore the area to an environmentally safe condition.

Our Groundwater Section is required to review projects in priority ranking order. Due to the low priority of your site it will be an extended period of time before our staff can complete a review of your particular project. However, be assured that at some time in the future your site will be reviewed for compliance. If compliance with applicable regulations does not exist, we will have no recourse except to refer the matter for enforcement action. You should be aware that an enforcement action could result in civil fines of up to \$10,000.00 per violation for each day that you have allowed the situation to continue without taking the required action.

Any questions about your responsibility in this area should be referred to your legal counsel.
