This is to acknowledge receipt of the subject lab results for the Diesel contaminated soil dated April 28, 1994, and received in the Fayetteville Regional Office on April 29, 1994. The Groundwater staff of the Fayetteville Regional Office has determined that you have met all the requirements specified in your permit No. SR0600043. You are hereby granted permission to accept and treat the subject 160 cubic yards of contaminated soil.

Please be advised that the Fayetteville Regional Office must be notified at least forty-eight (48) hours before initial placement of the soil. Such notification to the regional supervisor shall be made during the normal hours from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. on Monday through Friday, excluding state holidays. This authorization does not constitute approval for trust fund reimbursement.
