SUBJECT: Underground Storage Tank (UST) Closure Assessment at NC DOT - Stratford Rd., Winston-Salem, Forsyth County


Dear Mr. Smith:

This letter is in reference to your letter dated April 25, 1995 regarding the subject site. After a careful reviewal of both files, NC DOT - Stratford Rd. and NC DOT - Corriher, I have to say that they are different sites although both of them are on Stratford Rd., your Project Numbers were the same -- 9.8091812, and both closures assessments were performed by AQUATERRA.

Our files indicate that two 580 gallon gasoline USTs were removed on June 19, 1992 at NC DOT -Stratford Rd. site and a certain amount of petroleum hydrocarbon contaminated soil was removed. Two 1,000 gallon USTs were removed from NC DOT - Corriher site on February 21, 1992 and no contamination was found during the closure at this site. Copies of these closure reports are enclosed for your reference. Please reply within 30 days from receipt of this letter.
