Part VII. Check List

Permanent Closure (For removing or abandoning-in-place)

Contact local Fire Marshall - performed by Joyner Wrecking Co.
prior to initial excavation of tank site. The original site
excavation and UST inspection and preparation for
abandonment in place was performed on August 2, 1991.

Notify DEM Regional Office Before Abandonment - DEM was notified
prior to initial excavation of site, as well as prior to
this Abandonment in Place by the filing of the Notice of
Intent: UST Permanent Closure or Change in Service. A copy
of the letter acknowledging the original notification is
enclosed.

The UST was scheduled for removal, but it was determined
that its proximity to, and undermining of, the foundation of
the building required that the UST be abandoned in place.
