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# PUBLIC NOTICE FROM THE HAZARDOUS WASTE SECTION OF THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES

The public is hereby notified that the Hazardous Waste Section is reviewing a request from American Distillation, Inc. (ADI) of 1690 N.E. Royster Road, Leland, Brunswick County, North Carolina, for a variance from classification as a solid waste certain recycled materials consisting of a mixture of isopropyl alcohol and methanol. The variance is proposed pursuant to the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) as amended by the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984 (PL 98-616) and the North Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Rules (15A NCAC 13A).

If a public meeting is requested and is determined by the Hazardous Waste Section to be appropriate, such public meeting would be held in Brunswick County before August 12, 1999. All parties requesting to do so will have an opportunity to present oral or written statements at such a public meeting.

The following is a summary of the proposed solid waste variance:

American Distillation, Inc. requests the Hazardous Waste Section to grant a variance from the classification as a solid waste certain mixtures of isopropyl alcohol and methanol it intends to recycle through its distillation process. ADI proposes to return methanol, cyclohexane and tertiary amyl alcohol to the originating facility and to use the recovered isopropyl alcohol (IPA) as a denaturant in its ethanol blending operation or to sell it as standard industrial quality IPA.

ADI requests the variance for a six month period with an 18 month extension to be issued at the discretion of the Hazardous Waste Section if ADI pursues a RCRA permit for a commercial hazardous waste management facility to continue management of this material.

All comments received during the public comment period or at any public meeting that may be held will be considered in the formulation of a final decision regarding this proposed variance.


