





The Washington Regional Office (WaRO) Underground Storage Tank (UST) Section received a Limited Site Investigation Report (Report) that included information for a petroleum release and a release of solvents to groundwater. The UST Section has ranked the petroleum release as Low 130D and we issued a Notice of Residual Petroleum Contamination for soil and groundwater on November 23, 2011 and once that is completed we will issue a "No Further Action" letter for only the petroleum release. **Therefore, the UST Section is referring the solvent groundwater contamination to the Inactive Hazardous Waste Branch.** Please find attached a copy of the Report.
