Dear Mr. Autry:

I represent the Hazardous Waste Section of the Division of Waste Management. The above-referenced matters have been referred to me for collection.

The Division of Waste Management issued the enclosed Short Form Compliance Order with Administrative Penalty on September 27, 2001, wherein the Division of Waste Management assessed a penalty against Filtek Filtration Products, Inc. ("Filtek") in the amount of \$480.00. Filtek did not exercise its right to appeal the penalty by requesting a hearing in the Office of Administrative Hearings within thirty days of its receipt of the Compliance Order. Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. §130A-22(g), we may file an action against Filtek in superior court to recover the full amount of the penalty assessed.

The penalty was assessed because Filtek violated N.C. Gen. Stat. §130A-294.1(j) and (o). That statute requires transporters of hazardous waste to pay an annual fee. Currently, Filtek owes a total of \$1,800.00 for unpaid transporter fees for the period of July 1, 1999, up to and including June 30, 2002.

A total of \$2,280.00 is past due at this time. Payment of the above-referenced penalty and transporter fees should be made by check or money order, payable to the Division of Waste Management, and mailed to Jill B. Pafford, Chief, Hazardous Waste Section, 401 Oberlin Road,

Suite 150, Raleigh, North Carolina 27605. If payment is not received on or before October 31, 2002, a civil action may be filed against Filtek to recover the full amount due.
