Dear Ms. Sharpe:

I have reviewed the Initial Site Sampling Plan submitted for the former Carolina Chemical Corporation facility located in Wilson, NC in response to the IANOV Docket Number 2006-203. The plan is approved with the following conditions:

1. DWM Hazardous Waste Section personnel must be on-site for the collection of soil samples. Either Dick Denton (252-758-9647) or myself (828-625-0171) may be contacted for this purpose. Sufficient notice must be given to allow for schedule coordination.
2. The level for determining if the concrete floor is clean will be to compare the contaminate levels found in the rinsate samples to the NC DWQ Stormwater Benchmark levels.
3. Sampling of unknown waste materials must include, in addition to those methods proposed, applicable pesticide and herbicide analytical methods.
4. Updates via phone or internet must be made to the Hazardous Waste Section Compliance Branch Chemist at least every two weeks for the duration of the project.

Please be advised that the compliance date for the completion of any remediation that may be required and the submission of a final Closure Report for this site is 180 days of the date of this letter (May 21, 2006).
