5. **Purpose of Inspection:** To determine compliance with 40 CFR 260-279

6. **Facility Description:**

This inspection is the result of a complaint called into the Mooresville Regional Office on November 19, 2007. Cindy Pruitt, with Cleveland County Environmental Enforcement, issued the complaint. Ms. Pruitt had received the complaint by telephone.

On November 27, 2007, Steve Barron, Mark Burnette, and I conducted a Compliance Evaluation Inspection at Shelby Motors. The facility operates as a Chrysler, Jeep, and Nissan dealership. We met with Mr. Chris Hogston at the time of the inspection.

The facility performs automotive repair and maintenance activities. The facility does not operate a body shop at this location. The facility generates used oil from oil changes. There were not any parts washers onsite and the facility does not generate any hazardous waste. Used oil is collected in a 250-gallon above ground tank located outside next to the garage area. The container was properly labeled and is equipped with a catch pan. Used oil spills were not noted around the container. The facility provided receipts for used oil collection. Haz-Mat, Inc collects used oil on a monthly basis.

At the time of the inspection we inspected the solid waste dumpster located outside next to the garage area. There was a small amount of used oil in the bottom of the dumpster that appears to have come from the disposal of used oil filters. We provided guidance on the proper draining of used oil filters at the time of the inspection.

On November 28, 2007 I spoke with Cindy Pruitt, with Cleveland County Environmental Enforcement, by phone. Ms. Pruitt explained that she was also the Solid Waste Enforcement Officer for the County. I explained my inspection findings and she stated that she would inform the waste management company that services the dealership. Ms. Pruitt also stated that they would conduct spot checks to assure that used oil is not being transported to a solid waste landfill. No other enforcement actions will be taken at this time.

9. Recommendations:

- It is strongly recommended that all used lead/acid batteries be stored in a covered area.
