On October 19, 2015, Duke Energy (Duke) notified the Division that the final placement of coal combustion product occurred at the Marshall Steam Station FGD Landfill (Permit No. 1804-INDUS). With that notification, Duke requested deference of closure activities. In a response from the Division dated October 20, 2015, Duke received approval to defer closure activities.

This letter serves as response to the Division expectations as follows:

2. Within six (6) months utilize temporary seeding to stabilize all areas of the landfill.
3. Notify the Section when each activity (above) is completed.

Response: Seeding was applied in November 2015, since then the area has stabilized and the photos below show the condition of the FGD Landfill as of April 8, 2016.
