Re: Hydrocarbon Contamination at the former EDACO Auto Recyclers, Asheville, NC

Dear Mr. Wingfield:

I have reviewed the Limited Phase II Environmental Assessment and the report of the Excavation and Sampling of the hydrocarbon contamination at this facility.

The contaminated soils under the parts of the facility affected by EDACO processes have been excavated, greatly reducing the potential for further leaching to groundwater. The remaining levels of contamination in the soil are below the EPA's industrial clean up levels. The contamination that remains appears to be from historical uses at this facility rather than by the processes used by EDACO.

While the HWS cannot issue "no further action" letters unless levels of contaminants are below the Hazardous Waste Sections Soil Screening Levels, there is no reason why this site cannot proceed with the NCDENR's Brownfield's Agreement program.
