Reason for visit: OTH – Complaint Investigation

REPORT:

I received a complaint which originated on 28 December 2007 from David Hance with the DENR customer service center. The anonymous complaint alleged that A-1 Hitch and Trailer Sales disposed of drums of paint waste and oil cans in a wetland area on the property.

On 3 January 2008 I visited the facility and discussed the painting activities and disposal of the waste. The paint and solvent used at the facility are non hazardous according to the facility personnel. The MSDS sheets for these materials are attached. All product material comes in five gallon containers as opposed to drums as the complaint alleged. The facility has historically been a CESQG so past manifests were not maintained on the property. At the time of this inspection I saw no indication of illegal disposal of hazardous waste.

There is evidence of filling of the swamp behind the property which Mr. Carson said had been occurring for years. I explained that other State agencies may visit the site to address the filling. Mr. Carson said they had already been but he did not know who they were. I attempted to contact DWQ personnel but no one responded to my call.

Based on this site visit, I see no reason for additional involvement of the Hazardous Waste Section.
