I have reviewed the Revised Assessment and Cleanup Plan for this site that was submitted by your contractor MACTEC Engineering.

Please address the following comments, either by post or electronic mail:

- 1 Please identify the location of the five samples to be used to determine the concentration of naturally occurring metals at the site.
- 2 Excavated soil must be place in covered roll-off containers.
- 3 Waste characterization samples must be analyzed using TCLP methodology.
- 4 Regardless of background concentration of metals, all post excavation, confirmation samples must also be analyzed for total metals.
- 5 The number and approximate location of post excavation confirmation samples must be addressed.
