REPORT:

Dick Denton & Harvy Cooper performed a site visit to orientate Ms. Cooper to the site. The inspectors were also able to speak with Mr. Law to discuss future sampling by the Section in August or September.

History:

Pamlico County Health Department's Chris Kent, received a complaint from a citizen regarding the alleged illegal disposal, and storage of various petroleum products and other unknowns. The property is owned by Mr. Fran Law of Merritt NC. Mr. Law's address is 11 Creek View Court, Merritt, NC 28556. Mr. Law's phone number is 252-249-9848, office - 252-745-4252.

Mr. Dick Denton, NC Hazardous Waste Section, assisted Mr. Kent with the complaint. The site visit revealed the following:

1. Approximately 12 fifty five gallon containers containing liquids which appeared to be petroleum type waste were stored on the property. The containers were observed to be rusting and not in good condition.
2. A 5 gallon container containing oily rags was overturned and had stained the ground with oil.
3. Approximately 6 lead acid batteries were observed stored on the ground.

4. A discarded vehicle fuel tank, partially full, had been discarded onto the ground.

Mr. Denton spoke with Mr. Law by telephone January 24, 2005 to inform Mr. Law of the impending Immediate Hazard Notice of Violation. Mr. Law stated that the material in the drums was contaminated diesel fuel and oil from the motors (2 diesel engines) which were in his 1963 Chris Craft boat.
