

We encourage you to become familiar with the North Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Rules that have been codified in the North Carolina Administrative Code at 15A NCAC 13A. You may obtain a printed copy of the rules for \$32.00 by contacting Lillie Hinnant at 919-508-8543. You may also access and print the rules from our Internet site at <http://www.wastenot.nc.org/HWHOME/WEBRules/NCDWRULE.html>. We specifically draw your attention to Rules .0101, .0102, .0106 and .0107. These provisions address the requirements potentially applicable to generators of hazardous waste. (We have also enclosed a copy of an EPA publication that explains these requirements).

If you are considered a Large Quantity Generator, a Small Quantity Generator, a Transporter, or a Treater, Storer or Disposer (TSD) facility, you are required to pay an annual fee in North Carolina. The invoice is attached with this letter. Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generators are not required to pay the annual fees that large and small generators, transporters, and TSD facilities are required to pay in North Carolina. These fees are used to support the State's programs to ensure the safe management of hazardous waste. If your regulatory status changes, an EPA Form 8700-12 must be completed and submitted to the North Carolina Hazardous Waste Section at the above address.

E. Update Your Information:

If your facility's generator status or information regarding the contact person has changed, you must notify the North Carolina Hazardous Waste Section of these changes by submitting EPA Form 8700-12 (RCRA Subtitle C Site Identification Form). EPA Identification Numbers are site specific, if your facility's physical location has changed, you must apply for a new number. Form 8700-12 can be obtained by contacting Larry Wilson at 919-508-8573, or you can download this form by using the web page address listed below.

F. Who is Required to Pay? You are required BY **LAW** to pay the fee(s) when your company is notified that it is a generator, transporter, treater, storer or disposer of hazardous waste as defined below.

1. **Large Quantity Generator** (\$1,000.00): A facility who generates one kilogram or more of acute hazardous waste or 1,000 kilograms or more of hazardous waste in any calendar month during the year beginning July 1 and ending June 30. Large Quantity Generators are also required to pay an additional fee of \$0.50 per ton, or any part thereof, for hazardous waste generated during the calendar year up to a maximum of 25,000 tons. **[Note: Large Quantity Generators must determine how much waste was generated in the calendar year of 2006. The calculated tonnage should be entered in the table located on the front of this invoice under the column heading Facility Status and in the Waste Generation row. To calculate the amount due, multiply the amount generated by \$0.50 and enter in the Amount Due column for Waste Generation. Total all the numbers in the Amount Due column for the Total Amount Due.]**
2. **Small Quantity Generator** (\$125.00): A facility who generates 100 kilograms or more of hazardous waste but less than 1,000 kilograms in any calendar month during the year beginning July 1 and ending June 30.
3. **Transporter** (\$600.00): A facility that transports hazardous waste.
4. **Treater, Storer or Disposer** (\$1,200.00): A treatment, storage, or disposal facility shall pay an annual activity fee for each activity. *(Note: A commercial hazardous waste storage, treatment, or disposal facility is also required to pay an additional fee of \$1.75 per ton, or any part thereof of hazardous waste stored, treated, or disposed of at the facility.)*
