I have reviewed the Certificate of Attainment of Cleanup Levels form submitted for this Site along with the April 12, 2012 Limited Site Assessment report prepared by ECS Carolinas, LLP. The information provided indicates that all contaminants detected are either below applicable remedial goals or within naturally occurring concentrations. The geophysical survey did not identify any active or inactive sources that would account for the previously reported anomalous detection of chlorinated solvents.

No additional action will be required unless the Department later determines, based on new information or information not previously provided to the Department, that the Site did not meet current standards or that the Department was provided with false or incomplete information.
