**4. DATE OF SITE VISIT:** January 29, 2015 (*not previously inspected*)

**5. PURPOSE OF SITE VISIT:**

An un-announced on-site inspection was conducted to evaluate the facility's compliance with hazardous waste management regulations (also known as the Resource Conservation & Recovery Act, RCRA) which are described at Chapter 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, (40 CFR) Parts 260-270, 273 and 279 and Title 15A Chapter 13 of the North Carolina Administrative Code (NCAC).

**6. FACILITY DESCRIPTION:**

John West Auto Services operates as an automotive repair and machine shop specializing in automotive repairs and service. The subject facility submitted initial notification to NC DWM as a Small Quantity Generator (SQG) of hazardous waste on February 2, 1995.

Used oil, used antifreeze, and scrap metal may be generated. Hazardous waste is not routinely generated on-site.

7. **AREAS OF REVIEW AND INSPECTION:**

John West Auto Service, Inc. is housed in a building that includes a front office, garage (for conducting auto repairs) and a machine shop. At the time of the inspection, it was determined that the facility routinely operates as a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator (CESQG) of hazardous waste and has been for the past >3 years.

**PHYSICAL INSPECTION/FACILITY WALK-THROUGH**

Hazardous waste is not routinely generated on-site and no hazardous waste was stored on-site at the time of the inspection. Empty aerosol cans are recycled as scrap metal (very small amounts are generated). The facility was equipped with land line telephones, fire extinguishers, and spill clean-up supplies.

**Used Oil** - Used oil is accumulated and stored inside the facility in one 250-gallon tank that was labeled with the words 'used oil'. Used antifreeze is recycled in an on-site unit. The facility utilizes one parts washer that is routinely serviced and maintained under contract with Safety Kleen.

**Universal Waste** – No universal waste was stored on-site at the time of the inspection. If generated, used batteries are shipped off-site to be recycled.


8. **SITE DEFICIENCIES:** No deficiencies were observed.

9. **COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS:**

**The cooperation and assistance of Mr. John West was greatly appreciated during the RCRA compliance inspection.** At the time of the inspection, John West Auto Service, Inc. was operating as a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator (CESQG) of hazardous waste and all requirements appeared to be met. It was noted that the facility was extremely clean and well organized.

Because the facility is no longer operating as a Small Quantity Generator (SQG) of hazardous waste, you may consider re-notifying DWM as a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator (CESQG). *Please find attached a blank 8700-12 form to be completed and submitted for subsequent notification (to change the facility's hazardous waste generator status from SQG to CESQG).*
