Dear Mr. Delaney:

North Carolina General Statutes (N.C.G.S) Section 130A-295(g) require that at each two-year interval after a permit for a hazardous waste facility is issued, the permit holder shall verify that the resources and equipment of each local government and emergency response agency are available and adequate to respond to an emergency at the facility in accordance with its role set forth in the contingency plan. In addition the facility must submit the verification to the Hazardous Waste Section.

This is verification that the resources and equipment of each local government and emergency response agency specified in the contingency plan are adequate for response to an emergency at the facility. If a person or organization has no role in the contingency plan then no verification is needed from that person or organization. Additionally, the facility is not required to send the contingency plan to the local government or emergency response agency at this time.

MCAS Cherry Point must provide this verification to the Hazardous Waste Section on or before December 8, 2014.
