On behalf of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Office of Research and Development, I am writing to request the renewal of our Administrative Order on Consent for Storage of Dioxin Waste, Docket # 2008-025 (Order)

The current Order became effective on February 22, 2008 and will remain in effect for five years. The Order covers dioxin wastes generated under EPA ID# NC6680090002 located at 2525 Highway 54 West, Durham NC, 27713. As there are currently no facilities located in the United States that are permitted to dispose of dioxin wastes, we are requesting renewal of the Order for a period of five years.

During the term of the requested five years, it is anticipated that all research activities at the above referenced facility will be moved to the U.S. EPA Main Campus located at 109 T.W. Alexander Drive, RTP, NC 27711. In preparation for this move, EPA has requested the provision for a one-time shipment of these wastes to the NIEHS/EPA Hazardous Waste Storage Facility in the renewal application for permit number NC27508900004. These materials would then be stored under the provisions of this permit until a disposal facility is available in the United States.


On behalf of the EPA, I am requesting the following changes be made to the renewed Order to address changes in staffing and senior management for US EPA, Research Triangle Park operations.
