REPORT: FCI/CMP

The facility was inspected following a complaint alleging a fuel spill in the yard, dumping contaminated soil over the fence, release of air conditioning gas into the atmosphere and improper disposition of used oil. Mr. Hunneke interviewed Mr. Gregg Bains, Plant Manager for the operation regarding the complaint detailed above. During the interview, Mr. Bains contacted Mr. Daniel Martin, Safety & Environmental Manager at the Company's Atlanta offices (440-443-4860 x4860) who participated in part of the interview via teleconference.

The subject facility is 12 acres and employs 12 individuals. The subject site, formerly owned by Greenleaf Auto Salvage was purchased by LKQ in 2010 for use as a heavy tractor-truck salvage operation. The site was previously inspected on May 25, 2011 when it was owned by Greenleaf under the Mercury Switch Recovery Program. The facility currently does not crush vehicles nor has any plans to crush vehicles. The facility does not generate mercury switches.

The facility currently has a Freon recovery system and three (3) 1,000 gallon above ground storage tanks to hold antifreeze, used oil and diesel. Used oil is burned onsite in a furnace to heat the garage. Safety-Kleen regularly removes antifreeze and un-usable diesel and occasionally used oil during the summer months. On the day of the inspection, the garage and surrounding yard was observed to be relatively clean and orderly. A walk of the perimeter fence surrounding the property indicated no evidence of spills, contaminated soil or other dumping of any kind. No adverse environmental conditions were observed.
