Dear Mr. Hall:

This office is in receipt of your letter dated October 8, 2015, requesting an extension of the 90-day time limit for the storage of hazardous waste by a generator without a permit in accordance with 40 CFR 262.34(b). According to your request, Robert Bosch Tool Corporation is in the process of disposing of chromium-contaminated concrete, which has been determined to be a D007 characteristic hazardous waste, and most of the D007 waste concrete has already been sent for proper disposal at Waste Management in Emelle, AL. Your letter further explains that because of the odd sizes of some of the waste concrete sections, not all of the waste concrete was able to fit in custom lined containers, made available by Waste Management, and additional containers could not be obtained before the expiration of the 90-day hazardous waste accumulation period on October 11, 2015. Based upon your request a 30-day extension is hereby granted for the storage of the waste. This is the maximum amount allowed under 40 CFR 262.34(b).

By November 10, 2015, you shall notify this office of the shipment of the waste by sending the Hazardous Waste Section a copy of the manifest signed by yourself or your representative and the transporter. 

Dear Mr. Burch,

Robert Bosch Tool Corporation (Bosch) is in the process of disposing of chromium-contaminated concrete exhibiting the D007 characteristic for leachable chromium. Most of the concrete has been removed for disposal using custom-lined roll-off containers provided by Waste Management in Emelle, AL. However, because of the odd sizes of the concrete sections, not all of the concrete was able to fit in the available lined containers. Additional containers cannot be obtained before the expiration of the 90-day accumulation period on October 11, 2015. Pursuant to Title 40, Code of Federal Regulations, section 262.34 (b), Bosch is requesting a 30-day extension of the waste accumulation period.
