REPORT:

Carolina Hydraulics is a machine shop that repairs hydraulic cylinders for heavy equipment. The facility also fabricates parts and occasionally fabricates entire cylinders. The facility has 14 employees that work one shift. The facility consists of one building. It uses municipal water and the municipal sewer system.

Used cylinders are cleaned in kerosene. They are disassembled and repaired as needed. Spent kerosene is disposed with used oil.

Only incidental amounts of hazardous waste is generated. The facility does not have a spray booth, but does some painting with aerosol paint cans. The facility offers chrome plating services, but this is outsourced to a plating company.

Used oil and hydraulic fluid is generated in the repair process. It is collected in a tank outside the building. The tank was labeled "Used Oil" and no spills were observed. Used oil is picked up by Nobel Oil.

CONCLUSIONS:

Carolina Hydraulics is operating as a CEG. No violations were observed.
