Dear Mr. Duncan:

Pursuant to N.C.G.S. §130A-310.39, prospective developers must pay a fee equivalent to the full cost to the Department and the N.C. Department of Justice of all activities related to the brownfields agreement. The U.S. EPA Grant provided to the Department for brownfields agreement negotiations previously offset these costs. However, recent reductions in this federal grant requires that these costs be fully borne by the Department. We have therefore concluded that for the addendum/modification you have requested the statute requires a fee from you in the amount of \$1,000.00.
