
The DENR North Carolina Brownfields Program (NCBP) received a Post-Construction Confirmation Sampling Plan, prepared by GeoScience Group and dated February 8, 2013, proposing additional Assessment for the above reference brownfields property. We have been notified the site activities will commence shortly. The overall sampling plan is approved, but the following needs to be addressed:

- Soil samples are to be analyzed for SVOCs according to EPA Method 8270, and for the metals Arsenic, Chromium, Lead and Mercury. Any sampling exhibiting staining or odor should be analyzed for VOCs by EPA Method 6260.
- A sampling report should be prepared and submitted to the Brownsfield Program for review.

Be advised that this approval from the Brownfields Program does not waive any applicable requirement to obtain any necessary permits, licenses or certifications for the above listed activities nor does it waive any requirement to comply with applicable law for such activities.
