
The Groundwater Section of the Mooresville Regional Office received the underground storage tank (UST) closure report for the subject site on May 8, 1992. A review of the submitted material indicates that no further action is required pertaining to the UST excavation.

The report does indicate, however, that contaminated soil from the excavation is still in temporary storage. If the total petroleum hydrocarbon levels in the stockpiled soil exceed the 10 parts per million action level, you must submit a remedial action plan (RAP) addressing the remediation or proper disposal of the contaminated soils. The RAP must be reviewed and approved by this Office prior to remediation or disposal.
