REPORT:

Performed site visit at the Shackleford site re: court related issues. No changes noted at the site.

4 Nov 2002, performed a site visit to determine the present status of the site. The inspection revealed that there has not been any activity at the site and there was no evidence that efforts are being made to secure the property with a fence. Furthermore, there has not been any correspondence with the Shacklefords by phone or US mail respective to the court order.

25 Oct 2002 performed a site visit to determine the present status of the site. The inspection revealed that there has not been any activity at the site respective to increasing or decreasing the inventory of tanks stored at the property. In addition there was no evidence that efforts are being made to secure the property with a fence.

17 Oct 2002 performed a site visit to determine the present status of the site. The inspection revealed that there has not been any activity at the site respective to increasing or decreasing the inventory of tanks stored at the property. In addition there was no evidence that efforts are being made to secure the property with a fence. A logging contractor has logged out the area adjacent and surrounding the tank site. The immediate area where the tanks are stored was not logged. In brief, with the exception of the logging operation no additional activity was observed at the site.

The site inspection revealed that the site has continued to remain active. Site photographs revealed that containers continue to be brought to the property for disposal/storage.
