



Sir/Madam:

SGL Carbon, LLC (SGL) is submitting this subsequent notification form 8700-12 to update contact changes and designate a change in status from Small Quantity Generator (SQG) to Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator (CESQG) of hazardous waste.

SGL manufactures graphite and other carbon products at our facility in Morganton, North Carolina producing only very small amounts of RCRA hazardous waste resulting from our maintenance activities. We have in place management practices; including weekly inspections to ensure we do not accumulate hazardous waste in amounts approaching 220 pounds per month and that any waste containers are removed expeditiously when filled. We accumulate this material in thirty-gallon drums to ensure volumes remain below the CESQG thresholds.

We will continue to manage our wastes in compliance with all state and federal regulatory requirements and in most cases exceed these. It is this facility's practice to meet or exceed all environmental requirements to remain compliant with our permits and other regulatory limits.
