On behalf of Univar USA, Environmental Resources Management (ERM) is providing a general status update of activities completed and/or planned for the former Daly-Herring facility in Kinston, NC. A Preliminary Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) was conducted in 2015-2016 to assess known or potential environmental conditions at or surrounding the facility. As part of the assessment, a visual inspection of the facility was conducted, and the historical environmental reports were reviewed. In particular, the results of the 2007 Pre-CERCLIS Site Screening and the 2009 Site Inspection were reviewed under the context of current North Carolina preliminary soil remediation goals.

Univar plans to conduct a limited site assessment in 2016 to confirm historical data and assess potential migration pathways. Based on the findings, Univar will evaluate whether additional actions are warranted, potentially including entering the site into the REC program. The work will be conducted in accordance with NCDEQ Inactive Hazardous Sites Branch guidance and procedures. A report summarizing the results will be prepared and submitted to NCDEQ upon completion.
