Complaint Info:

Mr. Robert Arrant intentionally neglects to use proper catch bins or pans for oil from the semi logging trucks when he changes it, he also intentionally neglects to use proper bins/ catch pans for transmission fluid or any fluid change on the semi-trucks , he also knowingly does not pay fuel taxes and transport logs from Georgia, North Carolina, Tennessee, and currently owes Georgia and North Carolina several fines for tickets pertaining to this fuel tax in fact an employee by the name of Shannon got a ticket for it just a day or two ago! Mr Arrant, also has a mobile home above his truck shop that he owns and there's sewage running from a P.V.C pipe down the hill and out onto the ground, he does know about this sewage because he ran the P.V.C himself because he did not want to replace a crushed septic tank line he ran over with his vehicle that runs into the septic tank in the back yard of the mobile home.....these environmental & legal tax violations have to be addressed before someone gets sick. It's wrong for all other People whom own & run semi trucks to have to pay their fuel tax , Mr Arrant doesn't and no-one should allow their feces & urine to pour on the ground, please help this is a nasty situation.

On-Site Visit: 01/29/16

Findings:

Site inspection occurred on January 29, 2016 at 10:30am by Jeff Menzel. The inspector was escorted through the property by the owner, Mr. Robert Arrant. The septic tank component of this complaint was referred to the Macon County Health Department but Mr. Arrant was advised to perform the necessary repairs to insure the septic tank and drain field are working properly.

Mr. Arrant explained how he changes the fluids for his two logging trucks. He collects the fluids in a plastic drip pan and then pours them into a 30 gallon tank. According to Mr. Arrant once the 30 gallon container is full he takes it to be recycled. I instructed the owner to collect all fluids when working on the trucks and dispose or recycle them properly. I also explained to Mr. Arrant that housekeeping measures need to be taken to avoid spills of any material.

No further action is required by Arrant Trucking at this time.
