ACTION DATA

The Hazardous Waste Section conducted a complaint investigation at Campaero, LLC. Mr. Small, Vice President of Operations for Campaero, accompanied Ms. Goldman during the site visit. The facility manufactures and distributes electronic equipment. The facility specifically makes components and adapters that go on the back of cables connectors (cable accessories) for helicopter equipment. The facility is Aerospace Certified. The interior of the facility appeared to be very well kept and maintained.

Noble oil picks up used oil at the facility approximately two times a year. During the inspection, four 55-gallon containers of used oil and one approximately 250-gallon tote of used oil were observed staged outside on pavement. All five used oil containers were unlabeled. Mr. Small was directed to label each used oil container as "used oil". During the inspection, four approximately 250-gallon open top totes containing metal turnings from facility manufacturing activities were observed stored outside on pavement in the same area as the used oil containers. One of the metal turning totes was leaking coolant oil from a closed valve on to the pavement. Mr. small was directed to clean up any used oil (used coolant) spills and insure that the used turnings oil is properly contained and any spills cleaned immediately. Mr. Small was requested to provide photo documentation that the used oil containers were labeled properly and that the spills in the areas of the turning we're also cleaned up.

On 4/7/2016, Mr. Small provided a pictures of the outside used oil and metal turning staging area after cleaned up activities. Mr. Small also provided pictures of the used oil containers properly labeled and a brief outline of plans to manage the area and prevent spills for the area.

All concerns were addressed and corrected.
