ACTION DATA

On April 13, 2016, Ms. Goldman with the Hazardous Waste Section evaluated the containers of concern. There were seven 55-gallon containers staged on wooden pallets at 300 Clanton Avenue, NC. Six containers were metal with rust observed. One container was a plastic (poly) blue container. The business located onsite was identified as USTT, Inc. a job placement company.

The company was reached out to by telephone and e-mail. On April 19, 2016, Mr. Gavilan contacted the Hazardous Waste Section and explained that there was used oil from company vehicle oil changes that ceased around 2003. Mr. Gavilan agreed to have the used oil picked up for recycling.

On April 20, 2016, Mr. Gavilan provided a copy of the used oil receipt from Haz-Mat Environmental Services, Charlotte, NC. 330-gallons of used oil was removed from the property on April 20, 2016. The remaining containers consisted of trash. Ms. Goldman recommended that the remaining containers be sent for metal recycling.

No violations cited.
