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ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

1. Signage present as you arrive at Field 2.
2. Access road was in good shape.
3. Markers present.
4. All septage discharges appeared to be within the permitted boundaries of the 3 fields.
5. No spot dumps or thick applications noticed today.
6. At time of inspection, Field 3 was being mowed with a bush hog. Bermudagrass needs to be harvested for hay and not just mowed. The small grain had not been planted yet. Need to get the small grain planted as soon as possible.
7. No application at time of inspection. pH not checked.
8. No objectionable odors noticed today. A slight septage odor was noticed on the fields due to recent applications.
9. No change noticed that would affect any of the setback distances.
10. Land application records are to be sent on a monthly basis as stated within Condition 17 of your permit. Please send me your land application on a monthly basis.
