Findings:

HWS staff Investigated the complaint on 4-29-2016. The facility is not currently operating as a body shop due to a fire that destroyed the garage area. The site is used as a storage area for various car parts, and old classic cars. Three (3) tractor truck trailers are onsite and used to store car parts and small consumer goods. Several containers of various sizes ranging from paint cans to 55-gallon drums were observed in various places around the site. The vast majority of the containers were empty with the exception of two 55-gallon containers that were filled with rain water. Two large home heating oil tanks were observed toward the rear of the property and were observed to be empty. No signs of leaks or spills were observed during the inspection. It was recommended to Mr. Caudill that the empty containers and containers with rain water be removed from the property and properly disposed of if there is no longer a use for them.

No further action is required at this time.
