

AREAS OF CONCERN AND COMMENTS:

- 1) A complaint was received of issues on a septage land application site in Columbus County. No specifics was given in the complaint as to the issue or location of the site.
- 2) A quick inspection was done of the site to make sure that there were no major crop or application issues. It was raining at the time of inspection. I did not noticed any major issues with the field. I met briefly with the landowner. He did not know of any issue with the site.
- 3) I did not confirm that a small grain crop (rye) had been planted on the Fields. A crop is needed on the fields for the winter months if septage is going to be applied to the fields.
