Dear Mr. Powell:

The NC Division of Waste Management has closed out permit, #**SLAS-31-15**, issued to Mr. Lloyd Smith under Lloyd Smith Septic Tank for the operation of a septage land application site in Duplin County off of Carr Town Road. The Division was unable to issue a permit for this site due to the applicant's inability to provide updated authorizations from the current landowners. The last soil analysis noted no lime requirements for the crop which meets the requirements of Septage Management Rule .0843 (e) for site closure. A final inspection conducted on January 28, 2015 noted that no discharges had been made to the site.

As of this date, permit #SLAS 31-15 has been closed out and this site shall no longer be utilized for septage land application. If in the future you wish to obtain a permit for a septage land application site, please contact this office to initiate the permitting process. The use of a septage land application site that is not permitted may result in administrative penalties up to \$15,000 per violation in accordance with NC General Statute 130A-22.
