W&R is gearing up for the next round of sampling at Nexus Church and Leather Trimmings, which they are currently planning for the last week of August. For the next round of sampling W&R (and Trex) is proposing an 8-hour vs. 24-hour composite samples, as this would be more representative of IA and OA conditions during a typical day, and would be in line with the requirements set forth in your letter of March 23, 2016 (“The sampling event must be representative of the working conditions”).

As this is a change from the past sampling conditions W&R and Trex are requesting confirmation from NCDEQ that the 8-hour sampling meets with the conditions as set forth in the March 23, 2016 letter. This request is being made to ensure the proper regulators are obtained for the next sampling event.
