Ray and Paul – as you know, vinyl chloride concentrations in surface water have exceeded applicable health standards. The State, in conjunction with New Hanover County, is working on developing signage to post along the unnamed tributary from FNW-3A to CR-1. Obviously, we will select areas of high visibility for maximum impact. The language that will be used has been agreed upon. I am waiting for a mockup of the sign or I would include it in this email.

There is a problem with access. The New Hanover Deputy County Attorney indicates that we need to have permission or “right-of-entry” to post signage. It is my understanding that you had previously negotiated a right-of-way access agreement with the County for purposes of monitoring well installation. Is that correct? Is there any way that access agreement speaks to installation of signage or is it too specific? If you could provide me with some specifics, I will pass it on to the necessary parties.

We can talk about this any time you are free. I am available both today and tomorrow.
